

2019 Rec & Rec Plus Dick King (end of season tournament) Playoffs

- At the completion of the Rec & Rec Plus season, the single-elimination end of season tournament, Dick King playoffs will produce the champions of each age division. Pairings & qualification for the playoffs are determined by regular season standings.
- The Dick King end of season playoffs (Rec & Rec Plus) are for all Mustang Soccer ONLY U9 - U19 teams.
- All Mustang Soccer Rec & Rec Plus teams U9 - U19 will play in the 1st round of the Dick King playoffs starting the weekend of November 3rd (Sunday) and then continuing with playoff games along with Championship & Consolation games through the week and on the following weekend of November 9th and 10th with several exceptions as indicated in the brackets.

Reporting Regular Season Game Scores for Standings

To complete the season standings, it is CRITICAL that ALL game scores get reported via the process below no later than the evening of Saturday, November 2nd for those teams with games on that day. All other teams should have scores entered since those leagues finished on Oct 26th.

- Standings for Rec & Rec Plus U9 - U19 are on the Mustang Soccer website at www.mustangsoccer.com. Click the MUSTANG GAME SCHEDULES tab on the HOME PAGE. Click on the appropriate league, age group, and gender. Ties in the standings at the end of the season will be determined by:
 1. 1st Head to Head Results
 2. 2nd Total Wins
 3. Team with the fewest losses
 4. Team allowing the fewest goals
 5. Team with highest goal differential (limit to 3 per game)
 6. Coin flip

2019 Dick King (end of season tournament) Playoff Rules

- **Home teams** are the team that is the higher seed in the game and will wear red jerseys, select the sideline they wish to occupy and provide the game ball and card. **Parents and players of one team will stay on one side of the field with their team while the parents and players of the other team will be on the opposite sideline with their respective team.**
- **Visiting teams** are the lower seed in the game, will occupy the opposite side of the field and will wear white jerseys.
- **Both teams** are responsible for setting up the field at the first game and taking the goals down at the end of each day. (Check brackets.)
- **Referees:** The League will attempt to assign 3 neutral referees to all games, but teams should be prepared to supply referees should neutral referees not be available.
- **Completed game scores must be reported via the directions that were sent to all coaches and also listed below by the winning team ASAP after the completion of the game** so that we can keep the standings current. Brackets will be updated on the Mustang website after the 1st weekend of play. **However, each winning coach is responsible for keeping track of where and when their next game is.**

Awards: teams in age groups U9, U10, U11 & U12 will receive trophies for 1st and 2nd place and medals for 3rd and 4th place. The teams in age groups U13/U14, U15/U16 and U17/U19 will receive championship Dri-fit shirts for 1st place and medals for 2nd place.

Length of Games:

Please review times and shootout procedures with referees before all games – they may not be aware of the procedures.

U10	Two 25-minute halves	Two 25-minute halves
U12	Two 25-minute halves	Two 30-minute halves
U14	Two 30-minute halves	Two 35-minute halves
U16	Two 35-minutes halves	Two 40-minutes halves
U19	Two 35-minutes halves	Two 40-minutes halves

Tie games in the preliminary round go directly to shootouts. Ties in semi-final and final rounds have two 5-minute halves/Golden Goal. If still tied, shootout per FIFA rule sheet.

Rules for all shootouts will follow FIFA guidelines for Kicks from the Penalty Mark. Only players on the field at the end of regulation play may participate. No players may leave or enter the field at this time. Details are to be found in the document "Procedures to Determine the Winner of the Match."

Please note that for the 2019 season, we will be applying the following structure to age groups that have multiple teams by grade player attends in school and the same age group and gender:

U9B Rec
U10B Rec
U11B Rec Plus
U12B Rec Plus
U9G Rec
U10G Rec
U11G Rec Plus
U12G Rec Plus

There will be a championship game and consolation game in each division guaranteeing 4 teams in each division winning awards. The purpose for this is to balance out some of the unbalanced divisions. This will make games at the end more equitable for all teams. This should help to balance out competition for all teams.

Dick King Playoffs Reporting Score Instructions

How to Report Scores

The **PhoneltIn Mobile app** will be used to report scores from your mobile device. For those with iPhone or Android devices, a free app allows easy score reporting with no phone call required.

Below are the steps to enter your game scores:

1. Go to <http://www.mustangsoccer.com/PhoneltIn/> on your phone. Teams who are using the Demosphere TeamNet app will also see a link for PhoneltIn.
2. When asked, say or enter the pin # of the event. Your pin # of the event. Your pin # for the Dick King Playoffs is **8775**.
3. Enter the game #.
4. You will then be shown the division, teams playing and field location – if this is the correct game, confirm by saying YES.
5. Next, enter the score for each team and then confirm.
6. You can do more games in the same call, or just say goodbye when done.

Remember, you cannot have two games with the same game number to use the PhoneltIn system. The schedule/standings on the website will update automatically.
