

Mustang Soccer Financial Aid Application Process

You are receiving this packet because you have indicated that you are interested in receiving Financial Aid in order to participate in the Mustang Soccer program. In order to be considered for financial aid, please read the following directions. Please submit all necessary paperwork by the financial aid deadline in order to ensure a prompt response to your inquiry.

Financial Aid Guidelines

1. Need must be demonstrated for consideration.
2. Mustang cannot meet 100% of the need. While we try to address as much of the need as possible, the amount of aid offered to any one player will be based on the number of players demonstrating need, the extent of that need and the budget available for Financial Aid.
3. For players 14 and older there are additional income opportunities to earn money toward soccer expenses not covered by Financial Aid.

 - Tournament Employment –
 - Corporate Sponsorship – Seek individual sponsorship from local businesses or corporations that will sponsor players
 - Sell advertising for Mustang Tournaments or Community Sponsorships and a percentage of those revenues will be credited toward a players fees.

To be considered you must:

1. Supply a copy of the front page of your 2007 filed federal tax return
2. Supply any additional documentation that will demonstrate financial need
3. All applications and supporting document must be submitted by the following deadlines:

April 30: Division 1 U9-U14

June 15: Division 4 - all ages & Division 3 U9-U15

June 15: Divisions 1 and 3 U15 & older
